Prices include tuition, room and board, Worldwide Medical Insurance (for non-US residents), all specialty camps, horseback riding lessons, bowling and swimming trips, and all weekend trips (fees included in boarding prices only). The application fee, textbooks, all class and lab material fees are also included. The higher price for Elementary and Middle School students provides for the extra service, personal care and attention necessary for younger children. Payment in full is due no later than June 1, 2018.

International classes are for students at a beginning or intermediate level of English.

Early registration discount available for a limited time and to a limited number of students. Additional discounts may also be available.

Shorter summer sessions may be available to younger students.

Transportation Information

Transportation for students between the school and the Portland Airport, bus or train stations will be provided at no charge on scheduled enrollment and departure days, providing the student is scheduled to arrive or depart before 9pm. Enrollment days are Monday, June 25th, Monday, July 2nd and Monday, July 9th. Students depart on the Monday following their last week, except for the final week, when students depart on Saturday, August 4th. Exceptions to enrollment and departure days must be arranged with Admissions.

Application Fee

A non-refundable fee of \$50 per student is required for application to the school.

Deposit

A tuition deposit is required to secure a place in the school. Deposit amounts are \$450 for the boarding program and \$225 for the day program. The deposit is repayable or transferable to a future term at the request of parents up until two weeks before the scheduled enrollment date, after which it becomes non-repayable and non-transferable.

Payment Options

Cash, checks (drawn on a US bank and in US dollars), e-checks and bank wires are the recommended methods of payment. Credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover) are accepted for payment of school fees. Because the bank charges fees for this service, a convenience fee of 2% will be added when using a credit card and 1% when using a debit card.

Foreign families are strongly encouraged to use Flywire (www.flywire.com/school/delphian). In most cases the family can make the payment in their own currency and receive a lower rate than any bank.

Non-U.S. Resident Student Insurance

It is required that all students whose home address is outside the United States sign up with the Exchange Student Worldwide Medical Insurance Plan for primary medical coverage. The cost is \$66 per month and is included in the prices given for international students.

Weekend Trips and Activities

Weekend trip and activity fees are included in the total cost for boarding students. Day students may attend any weekend trip or activity and pay for it separately.
