Discounts There is a five percent discount for tuition, room and board if fully paid by August 1, 2018.

Application fee	A non-refundable fee of \$100 per student is required for application to the school.		
Deposit	A tuition deposit (\$1,000) is required to secure a student's place in the school. Upon request the deposit is repayable or transferable to a future enrollment period until four weeks before the scheduled enrollment date, after which it becomes non-repayable and non-transferable.		
Payment options	Cash, checks and e-checks (drawn on a US bank and in US dollars), and bank wires are the recommended methods of payment. Credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover) are accepted for payment of school fees. Because the bank charges fees for this service, a convenience fee of 2% will be added when using a credit card and 1% when using a debit card.		
	Foreign families are strongly encouraged to use Flywire (www.flywire.com/school/delphian). In most cases the family can make the payment in their own currency and receive a lower rate than any bank.		
Materials fee	Materials include library, computer and science lab equipment and supplies, student accident insurance, and all routine classroom materials except writing supplies.		
Non-U.S. resident student insurance	It is required that all students whose home address is outside the United States sign up with the Exchange Student Worldwide Medical Insurance Plan for primary medical coverage. The cost is \$69 per month and a one-time fee of \$31 for sports coverage. The full amount is due upon enrollment, at which time the insurance policy will take effect.		
Student accounts	Each boarding student needs personal spending money for weekly allowances, optional weekend excursions and special trips. Students will need a credit or debit card to be used for such expenses during the school year. The school has an ATM machine for the occasional times when cash is needed. A maxium of \$100 cash is allowed on hand.		
Transportation Information	Transportation for students between the school and the Portland Airport, bus or train stations will be provided at no charge on scheduled enrollment and departure days, providing the student is scheduled to arrive or depart before 7PM. Students are expected to adhere to the scheduled arrival and departure days.
